Även online lektioner & övningar gav poäng till slutbetyg. Några inspelade föreläsningar och zoom-undervisning. Kontinuerlig examination. Hemtentamen med quiz-del och essäfrågor-del. Litteraturprojekt med student peer-review.


### 2. Sammanfattning av studenternas kursvärderingar




The reflections after each lecture was a very good way of following along the course, and you learn more by doing so. This made studying for the exam much easier.

### Learning factors from the literature that LEQ intends to examine

We tend to learn most effectively (in ways that make a sustained, substantial, and positive influence on the way we think, reflect, act or feel) when:

- a) We are trying to answer questions, solve problems or acquire skills that we find interesting, exciting or important
- b) We are able to speculate, test ideas (intellectually or practically) and learn from experience, even before we know much about the subject
- c) We are able to do so in a challenging and at the same time supportive environment
- d) We feel that we are part of a community and believe that other people have confidence in our ability to learn
- e) We understand the meaning of the intended learning outcomes, how the environment is organized, and what is expected of us
- f) We have adequate prior knowledge to deal with the current learning situation
- g) We are able to learn inductively by moving from concrete examples and experiences to general principles, rather than the reverse
- h) We are challenged to develop a true understanding of key concepts and gradually create a coherent whole from the content
- i) We believe that the work we are expected to do will help us to achieve the intended learning outcomes
- j) We are able to try, fail, and receive feedback before, and separate from, each summative assessment of our efforts

- k) We believe that our work will be considered in an honest and fair way
- I) We have sufficient time for learning and devote the time needed to do so

- m) We believe that we have control over our own learning, and not that we are being manipulated
- n) We are able to collaborate with other learners struggling with the same problems







#### What would you suggest to improve? (I worked: 3-5 timmar/vecka)

The exam was too loosely connected to previous lectures. Since the home exam was so long with access to the whole internet then theoretically you could pass the course just by finding good references.

#### What would you suggest to improve? (I worked: 9-11 timmar/vecka)

Some lectures had very overlapping elements, each guest lecturer often started with a broad introduction in their lectures which often contained the same information. This is both good for repetition but also tedious to spend time on.

The number of given lectures in person was very low. It is clear that helding lectures online is very convenient for teachers as well as for students, however, the quality of teaching suffers greatly. I would be nice to have the teachers back on campus so they can do their job of teaching proberly.

I really liked everything so I have no suggestions here.

#### What would you suggest to improve? (I worked: 12-14 timmar/vecka)

It could be nice to have more lessons. Since the questions are mixed as opposed to the reflections, it makes one put more consideration into it.

I think the home exam was really good, but using just 200 words per question was sometimes a bit tricky. Also the level of the lectures was overall really good, but varied for some of them.

#### What would you suggest to improve? (I worked: 18-20 timmar/vecka)

since i found the reflections to be the best part, i would suggest that they are made mandatory. additionally, having some time to discuss the reflections and / or the project presentations with my classmates would have been fun and useful. although this was likely mostly hindered because of the online form of teaching, more discussion among classmates is always fun!
