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COURSE DESIGN

Briefly describe the course design (learning activities, examinations) and any changes that have been implemented since the last course offering.

No changes since last round.

The course consists of three modules with approx 6 lectures and 2 exercise per module. For two of the modules there is also a small "lab" involving configuration and analysis of automation and protection devices.

The examination is in the form of project assignments - for each module. Passing the assignment is sufficient for passing the course, and passing with bonus enables a grade unto C. For higher grades, two voluntary individual tests are offered.

THE STUDENT'S WORKLOAD

Does the students' workload correspond to the expected level (40 hours/1.5 credits)? If there is a significant deviation from the expected, what can be the reason?

Appears to be lower than 160 hours, Reason most likely that the work is very focused on the project assignments.

The students are not very satisfied with the course wrt LEQ fields 14, 15 & 20. This includes matters such as not getting enough time to for exercises compared with assessment and not having opportunity to choose what to do. Women appear comparatively even less satisfied with these aspects - reason unknown.
