



I loved the content and format of this course.



My research area overlaps with part of the course content and so far I only engaged with that part. This course probided me a general understanding and background information about the content of the course where my research interest is part of it.



The online aspect of the course scared me a bit but it ended up being very dynamic, fun and relaxed.






Not hard as in difficult, but did a lot of thinking that took me quite some time.






Excellent combination, would have loved to have more of Shaowen!!!!
