Fewer and larger assignments. Maybe not every week but some weeks could be one larger assignment instead of two (three with the quiz) smaller ones.

What would you suggest to improve? (I worked: 36-38 timmar/vecka)
I enjoyed studying the course. However, one thing that bothered me a little was that some of the information in the learning materials was a little outdated. So I often couldn't see the recommended links. I also thought it might be easier to read if I could see the texts directly as plain texts instead of embedded texts. I was also confused about LEXA. I guessed whether I should submit something to the LEXA at the end needed to be submitted as a separate assignment or not. Thus, it might be better not to let students see the LEXA item.

What advice would you like to give to future participants? (I worked: 6-8 timmar/vecka)
Take your time and just write.

What advice would you like to give to future participants? (I worked: 36-38 timmar/vecka)
The first step is to read the study texts carefully and follow their contents. Also, learning strategies are critical, as described in the material. To do that, we need to know ourselves well. In other words, it is necessary not only to study English but also to check our learning tendencies.
