

SK2811 (Fiberoptical Communication)

Course evaluation HT2020

The course had this year eight registered students of which seven students attended the lectures. Due to the pandemic, the course was given in parallel via Zoom and in classroom. However, later in the course when pandemic situation became worse, all students preferred to take it via Zoom. Moreover, due to the pandemic, the two laboratory works had to be replaced by home assignments and a simulation study. Also, due to the pandemic the exam was replaced by home assignments.

All seven students passed the exam with results ranging from C to B. An evaluation questionnaire was sent out. Only one student responded with positive feedback about the course content, the lectures and simulation study but expressed disappointment of the lack of hands-on experience due to the pandemic.

Hopefully, the pandemic situation has improved until next year. The course is every year updated with the latest research results, including information about the research done in the field at KTH. No major changes of the course content are planned.
